Explore Victoria's Rocky Shores

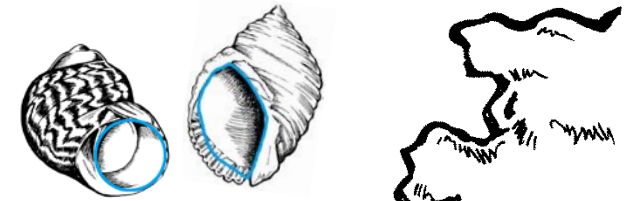

Use the guide **Explore Victoria's Rocky Shores to help name these rockpool creatures.**

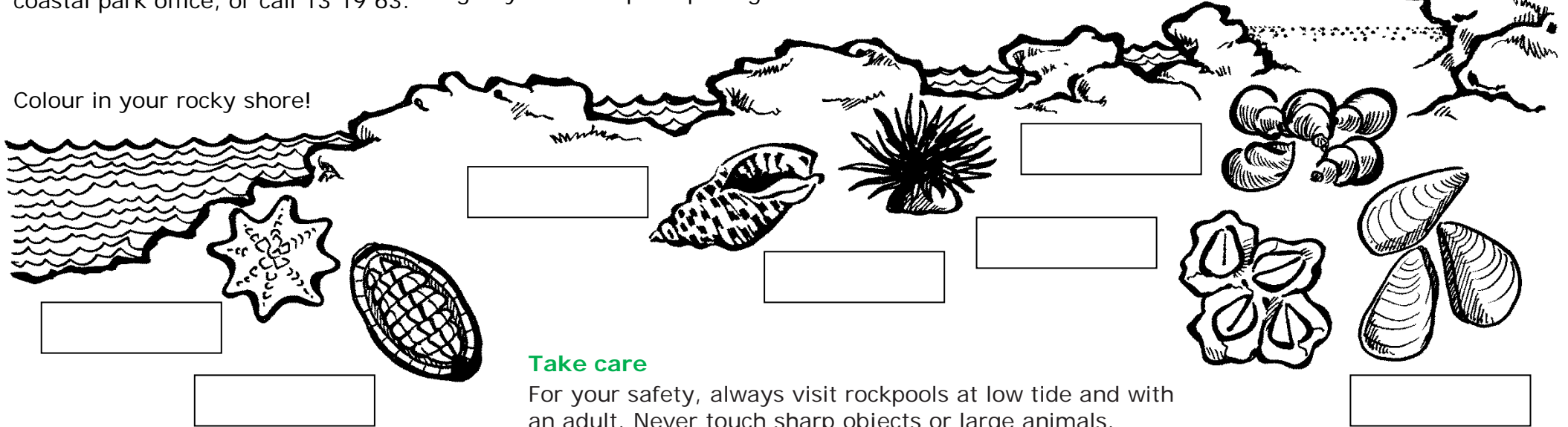

Did you know?

You can tell what a snail eats by the shape of their shell opening. Herbivorous snails have a circular 'salad bowl' opening and eat plants, while carnivorous snails have a 'gravy boat' shaped opening and eat meat.
